

Memorial West Community Club Information

This guide contains information regarding the amenities offered by the Memorial West Community Club including pool parties, clubhouse rentals, tennis court reservations, gate codes, guest policies and other club rules. FACILITY

The pool is made up of a lap pool, baby pool, and recreational pool. The pool is only open to Memorial West Community Club members and guests. A playground and tennis courts are also available to club members. There is a large club house available to rent for functions.

The lifeguard company is Texas Aquatic Enterprises. Please route any questions and concerns regarding the pool to Jessica Loving at Crest Management jessica@crest-management.com or 281-945-4667.

The front gate of the facility is open during the summer when the recreational pool is open. At other times, the facility may be accessed through the side gate near Memorial drive. Use the **access code 421** on the key pad located on the gate.

We have free Wi-Fi at the club, the password is Summer2013.

GUESTS

Guests are limited to 4 per family at no cost. Members must pay a \$3.00 guest fee for each additional guest. Members are responsible for their guests and for advising them of club rules.

GENERAL CLUB RULES

- You may bike, skateboard, or roller skate to the club, but please remember these are not permitted on Club walkways. DO NOT leave your equipment at the entrance to the pool. There is no running inside the gate.
- The lifeguards will be enforcing club rules. Please cooperate with their instructions.
- At all times in all areas of the club (including the pools, playground and tennis courts) be courteous to other people. Profanity, abusive or threatening remarks or behavior; acts of violence or causing physical injury to another person; intentionally damaging the property of another person; and intoxication are not allowed.

GENERAL POOL RULES

- Lifeguards have the full authority to enforce the all club rules, including those that relate to the pool. For the safety and enjoyment of all, lifeguards have full authority to remove from the pool area anyone disobeying the rules or endangering the safety of himself or another person.

- No swimming is allowed in the recreation pool unless a lifeguard is on duty. Anyone caught swimming in these pools after hours will be considered trespassing.
- Lifeguards will have periodic safety breaks, during which they will ask swimmers to clear the pool for a short period of time. Swimmers must all comply with this direction immediately.
- The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather, operational difficulties, or overcrowding at the discretion of the lifeguards. In case of lightning or thunder, Red Cross current standards will be used.
- All pools will be closed during swim meets. This occurs approximately twice per year.
- All children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times 18 years of age or older, to be admitted to the pool area. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Members must sign in their guests and be responsible for them at all times. If the member leaves, so must the guest.
- Proper swimming attire must be worn. Cut-offs are not allowed in the pool.
- All infants not potty-trained must wear swim diapers or plastic elastic pants. Disposable diapers are not allowed.
- Running or rough play in or about the pool area will not be tolerated.
- No diving in areas 5 feet deep or less, per Texas code.
- No playing around pool drains.
- Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
- Glass containers are not allowed in the pool area.
- Smoking is prohibited inside the pool gates and near any entrances.
- Everyone must exit the pool area at closing time so lifeguards can clear the area. This includes removal of all personal items.
- Lifeguards are employed to ensure the safety of the swimmers. Talking with the lifeguards on stand is prohibited.
- The Board reserves the right to immediately remove from any of the pools anyone engaging in unsafe or disruptive behavior.

DIVING BOARDS

- NO swimming in the deep end while the diving board is open. Swimmers may be asked to pass a swim test to be allowed in the deep end and or use the diving board(s).
- NO catching swimmers coming off of the diving board(s).
- Only one (1) person on the diving board or ladder at a time.
- Only one (1) bounce allowed on the board.

- Divers must wait for the person in front of them to reach the side of the pool before they dive.
- NO FLIPS, NO HANDSTANDS, NO inward dives allowed.
- NO wearing water wings, floaties, goggles, fins, masks, etc. while diving.
- NO running off the diving board.
- NO hanging or sitting on the diving board.
- The weight limit for the diving board is 250lbs.

BABY/WADING POOL

- All pool rules apply to the baby pool
- The baby pool is NOT guarded by the Lifeguards. Parents, watch your children and stay within arm's reach.
- No one is allowed to sit on or block the water coming from the fountain in the Baby Pool.
- Baby Pool is for young children only. Do not allow your older children to rough house in the baby pool, including during safety breaks.
- Please make sure your child is wearing a proper swim diaper. Report any mishaps to the Lifeguard immediately.
- If you see a situation that needs to be addressed, please notify the lifeguard.

LAP POOL

- Lap Pool is for swimming laps. Lap swimmers always come first.
- The Lap Pool is not monitored by the Lifeguards. Swimmers must take responsibility for themselves and their minor children.
- Children who are under the age of 12 and swimming laps must be accompanied by a parent at all times regardless of how well the child can swim. Parents must be ready to enter the water at the first sign of any trouble.
- Swim Team uses the Lap Pool in the evenings during the month of May and during the month of June from 7:30 a.m. until 12 p.m., Monday through Friday.
- Aside from Swim Team use, the Lap Pool is CLOSED on Mondays for cleaning.
- If you see a situation in the lap pool that needs to be addressed, please notify a lifeguard for assistance.

MWCC POOL PARTY POLICY

- All Pool Parties should be reserved through the Lifeguard Company. Unscheduled parties are not permitted as it creates safety issues in the pool.

- There will be an administrative fee and fees for additional life guards to ensure the safety of all patrons. The lifeguard company will determine the number of lifeguards needed.
- Guest fees are not charged for parties, the administrative and life guard fees are charged in lieu of guest fees. We do not take a damage deposit; however, member will be responsible for significant damage during a party.
- All club rules apply during parties.
- Please contact the lifeguard company for additional rules involving a party by calling (713) 416-5161.

PLAYGROUND

- An adult over the age of 18 must supervise your children at all times while they are playing on the playground. Small children should be kept within arm's reach and older children should be within your eyesight.
- Shoes should be worn while playing on the playground.
- Flip flops can create a hazard and are discouraged.

TENNIS COURT

- Limit play to 90 minutes if others are waiting. Those who have reservations have priority. Please yield to others who have reserved the court.
- Courts may be reserved using an online reservation system. Contact Brian Montez at brian.montez@gmail.com for log in access.
- No pets, bottles, glass, or chairs on the courts.
- No skating, roller blading or skate boarding on the courts.
- Guests must be accompanied by a resident.

CLUB HOUSE RENTALS

- The Club House is available for rent to both members and non-members of the MWCC. Members receive a discounted rate from nonmembers.
- Club house rentals are scheduled through the MWCC Facility Manager, Brian Montez. He can be reached at brian.montez@gmail.com
- Club house rentals do not include rental of the pool. That is secured through the lifeguard company and is a separate fee.
